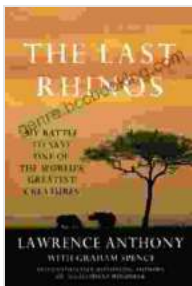

John is the founder and director of the Save the Elephants organization, which is dedicated to protecting elephants from poachers and promoting

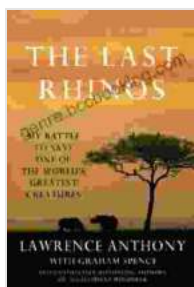
