



Reports as latest year in range. For Afrobarometer and Latinobarometro, graph combines "a lot" and "somewhat" into single positive value and "none" and "not much" into a single negative response. Graph excludes "don't know/no response" and calculations only include country averages with continuous data; to avoid composition effects.






